Layette Sweaters: minimum 10" underarm to underarm across back. Infant Sweaters (3-24 months): 10-13" underarm to underarm across back.

Layette Blanket (LG)	40" X 40"			
Isolette Blanket	25" X 25"			
Receiving Blanket (flannel)	30" X 30"			
Adult Lap Robe	36" X 36"			
Adult Afghan	48" X 72"			
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All Blankets may be knitted, crocheted, quilted or created with purchased fleece.

Note: Square blankets are best for swaddling.

Child Headband	2" to 3" wide		
Teen / Adult Headband	4" wide		
Child Scarf	24" to 48" long / 4" to 5" wide		
Teen / Adult Scarf	36" to 60" long / 6" to 8" wide
